## DECISION ON FIT CRITICAL FOR WIND ENERGY DEVELOPMENT IN VIETNAM

In order for Vietnam to meet its energy demands it is important to increase the energy capacity. With the slow in investment and the impact of Covid-19 on foreign investments, it is important that a transparent and reasonable FiT scheme will be announced as soon as possible.



## LAW ON COURT-ANNEXED MEDIATION AND DIALOGUE

This law intends to settle disputes outside court and will be applicable to various types of disputes, such as disputes concerning civil transactions, commerce, labour, marriage and family as well as administrative disputes. This is broader than the currently applicable Decree 22 which only applies to commercial disputes.

### **LAWS & REGULATIONS**

#### Decree No. 98/2020/ND-CP

Decree prescribing penalties for administrative violations against regulations on commerce, production and trade in counterfeit and prohibited goods, and protection of consumer rights. This Decree entered into force on October 15.

#### Decree No. 100/2020/NĐ-CP

This Decree provides guideline for duty-free businesses. It regulates the duty-free business management policies, the customs procedures and customs supervision for duty-free business. Decree 100 entered into force on 15 October 2020.

#### Decree No. 122/2020/NĐ-CP

This Decree guides the coordination and inter-agency procedures for establishment registration of enterprise, branches and representative offices, declaration of the use of employees, issuance of identification numbers of units participating in social insurance, registration to use corporate invoices. It intends to minimise the burden of administrative procedures for enterprises as well as help the government to collect the input data on enterprise registration. Decree 122 entered into force on 15 October 2020.

#### Circular No. 08/2020/TT-BLÐTBXH

This Circular provides guidelines for protection of employment status of whistleblowers working under labor contracts including their relatives, responsibilities of agencies, organisations and individuals in the protection of the protectee's employment status. This Circular entered into force on 15 October 2020.

#### Circular No. 73/2020/TT-BTC

This Circular amends Circular No. 134/2017/TT-BTC and provides guidelines for e-transactions on securities market and gives a clearer approach to the online securities trading system, form and placing of an electronic order. Circular 73 entered into force on 1 October 2020.
